



TOKISTAR LIGHTING INSTRUCTION MANUAL

C2-120-12V 12 VOLT/120 WATT TRANSFORMER

General

This transformer is to be installed in accordance with Article 450 of the National Electrical Code. The transformer must be installed in a well ventilated area free from explosive gases and vapors. Proper operation requires the free flow of air. Only a qualified electrician should install this hard wired transformer.

Precautions Before Installing

Check the label and ensure the transformer has the proper input voltage, output voltage and wattage for the job. Check the wire markings to ensure they match the wiring diagram on this instruction sheet.

Mounting

Select a suitable location capable of supporting the weight of the transformer. Use the four keyholes provided on the mounting flanges. The transformer must be mounted vertically with the wiring compartment pointing down.

Input Connections/Grounding

Remove the wiring compartment knockouts and install strain reliefs. With the power turned off, route the input wires through a strain relief and connect one wire to H-1 Hot and one to H-2 Common. For all wire connections use only UL Listed wire nuts and connectors of suitable size and type.

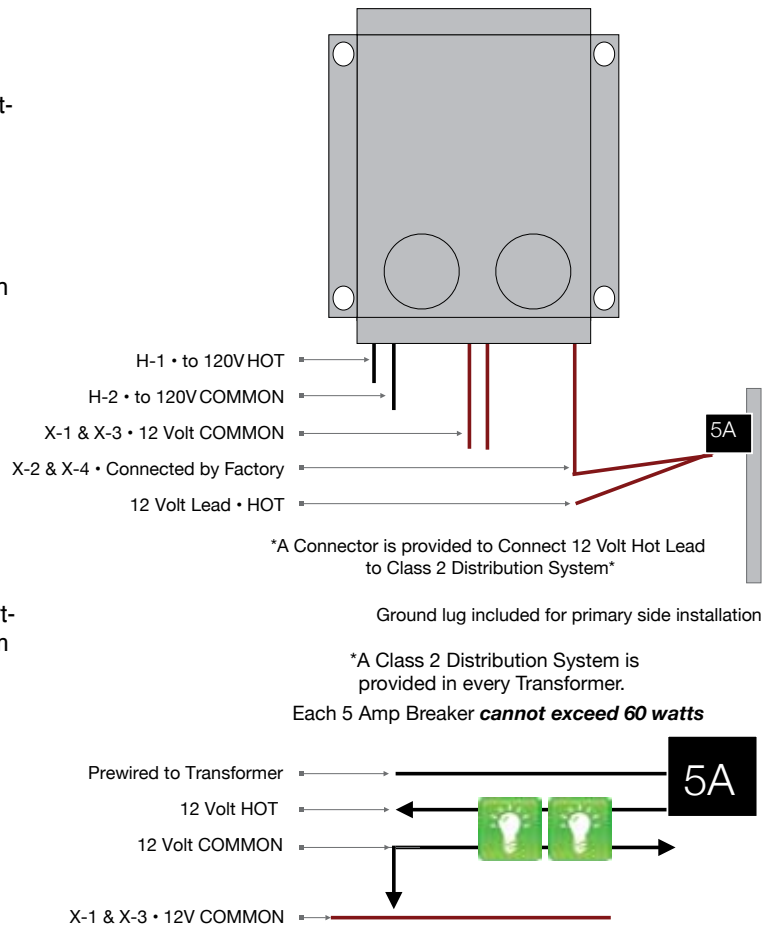
The transformer **MUST** be grounded in accordance with the N.E.C.

Output Connections

With all unused leads insulated, turn the power to the unit on. Check the secondary voltage to be sure it is right for the load. Turn power to the transformer off. Remove the wiring compartment knockouts and install strain reliefs for the lead wires from the lighting fixtures. Lighting fixture leads should be routed through the strain relief, connect one wire to the 12 Volt Hot and one to the 12 Volt Common.
